HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Hazards

- 1. Slips, trips and falls on the limestone rocks./
- 2. Ticks which can cause Lymes Disease.
- 3. Proximity to quarry edge.
- 4. Blasting.

Actions To Minimize Risks

- 1. Sign at quarry entrance explaining risks: Directions to Health and Safety information on LNR website (http://naturereserve.burtonweb.org.uk)
- 2 The quarry to post a sentry or take other action as appropriate if they consider blasting may affect the LNR area.
- 3. The Secretary to the Management Committee is responsible for ensuring that a twice yearly H&S check of the Reserve for hazards and damage is carried out and recorded in the H&S file.
- 4. Risk Assessment Form to be completed for groups sponsored by the LNR Management Committee working in the reserve, using the specific check lists for individuals or groups.
- 5. Any committee member identifying a potential H&S risk in the Reserve is to report such to the Secretary or Reserve Manager.
