HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Hazards

1. Slips, trips and falls on the limestone rocks./
2. Ticks which can cause Lymes Disease.
3. Proximity to quarry edge.
4. Blasting.

Actions To Minimize Risks

1. Sign at quarry entrance explaining risks: Directions to Health and Safety information on LNR website (<http://naturereserve.burtonweb.org.uk>)
2. The quarry to post a sentry or take other action as appropriate if they consider blasting may affect the LNR area.
3. The Secretary to the Management Committee is responsible for ensuring that a twice yearly H&S check of the Reserve for hazards and damage is carried out and recorded in the H&S file.
4. Risk Assessment Form to be completed for groups sponsored by the LNR Management Committee working in the reserve, using the specific check lists for individuals or groups.
5. Any committee member identifying a potential H&S risk in the Reserve is to report such to the Secretary or Reserve Manager.
